BACKGROUND

The organisation will operate out of 2 campuses, one in Collingwood and one in Epping, both leased from Melbourne Polytechnic (formerly NMIT) and on Melbourne Polytechnic Campuses.

The organisation plans to deliver 2 accredited courses (EAL) and two qualifications from the BSB Business Services Training Package at the Diploma and Advanced Diploma level.



The CEO, Mr Saraswat is also the CEO of Executive Security Training Pty Ltd (RTO 40526). The Collingwood location is also the administrative office for Executive Security Training Pty Ltd.
